This flows into a large lower deck with ample space for outdoor furniture and a barbeque, perfect for hosting gatherings. The two-car garage includes

shelving and a workbench, ideal for projects and hobbies. The yard is nicely landscaped with shrub beds and trees, along with two fenced garden areas and compost bins—ready for anyone with a green thumb.
